



# CORPORATE HISTORY

1991 Gartner coins the term ERP in 1990. Just one year later Bill and Lynne Henslee hire their first employee and form Henslee & Associates, Inc. specializing in ERP and custom business applications.

1991

1997 Haitek becomes developer for State of the Art Software's Acuity Financials (later Sage MAS 500) and begins development of Envision ERP - the next-generation of Shop IV in Microsoft VB and SQL.

1997

2004 Anytime 500 supply chain suite introduced for Sage MAS 500 adding new features for manufacturers including Enhanced MRP, Sales Forecasting, Quality Control, Engineering Change Orders, and more.

2004

2009 E2B acquires Michigan-based Ambrose Software International. Epicor ERP practice is born. Office move from Painesville to Chardon, OH.

2009

2012 Anytime Assets cloud-based software introduced. Anytime Collect OEM with Epicor (Epicor Cash Collect).

2012

2016 15th Anniversary. Solver BI360 added to ERP practice. Anytime Collect Express Edition introduced for smaller companies. Initial Zendesk support center launched for customers.

2016

1988 e2b technologies founder Bill Henslee starts consulting. Forms Vista Systems in CA. Later returns home to Ohio.

1988

1996 Company rebranded Haitek Solutions. Haitek's Shop-IV manufacturing software born from enhancements to Thoroughbred Software's Solution-IV accounting on IBM RS6000 servers and UNIX.

1996

2001 Sage acquires State of the Art in 1998 and then acquires Haitek Solutions in 2001. Envision ERP becomes 8 manufacturing modules in Sage 500. e2b technologies formed by former Haitek and Sage employees.

2001

2008 E2B introduces ARM- AR Management collections software for Sage 500 ERP, the precursor to Anytime Collect.

2008

2010 ARM rewrite in .NET deployed from Microsoft Azure. Introduction of Anytime Collect brand.

2010

2014 ERP practice expands to include Sage 100c and Sage X3.

2014

2017 Intacct cloud accounting added to ERP portfolio. First Innovate User Group Conference 9/12/17.
